URU is provided with a CLI version in order to add a scheduled task on operating system.

## **Solutions / Fixes**

URU CLI version is 'raidcmd' and it is located here:

C:\Program Files\Universal RAID Utility\cli>

Use the following command

raidcmd cc -c=x -l=y -op=start

where

x=controller number (first controller is number 1) y=logical drive number (first logical drive is number 1)

Note: there is no command to run consistency check on all logical drive of all controller in one shot.
